Action taken report

- 1. Lesson plan are prepared by all faculty members before commencement of new semester.
- 2. We have 10 smart boards and most of the teachers are using smart boards and using innovative teaching practices.
- 3. Demand for up gradation of labs has already been sent to the office of the director general higher education Haryana Panchkula.
- 4. As college do not have adequate staff due to this reason teachers are taking more classes than set norms decided by Higher education department.
- 5. Placement cell is asked to take appropriate action.
- 6. Head of the departments asked to submit the list of required books on time.
- 7. As college building is not handed over due to this proper canteen facility can not be provided to the students.
- 8. Many times Letter has already been sent to the Department for lab upgradation.
- 9. As far as tour is concerned tour can be organised only after getting grant from the department as college is not receiving any grant from last 3 to 4 years for the abovesaid purpose.
- 10. Water coolers are already provided on every floor in the college. Sometime SIstudents face drinking water problem as college is situated in rural area and due to electricity problem especially in summers. So college faces scarcity of water but we have enough water tanks in college.
